CIRCULAR

Subject: Setting up IMAP for aij.gov.in email account on Android smartphone or tablet

For availing optimum benefits of the official email account under aij.gov.in domain, the aij.gov.in email account users are advised to configure their official email account on their Android smartphones or tablets, so that the email account can be accessed anytime, anywhere and any new email is notified automatically and almost immediately.

The email account can be configured on an Android phone or tablet in IMAP protocol by following the steps given below:

- Go the **Settings > Accounts > Add Account > Personal (IMAP) / Email**
- Enter your Email Address, then select **Manual Setup**.
- Then select **IMAP** for Account Type.
- Enter the Password, and click **Next**.
- Enter the following information for Incoming mail server settings, wherever asked:

Username: Your aij.gov.in email user ID
Password: Your aij.gov.in email password
IMAP server: mail.gov.in
Security type: SSL/TLS(Accept all Certificates)
Port: 993 (may be displayed automatically)
Then, click **Next**

- Then enter the following information for Outgoing mail server settings, wherever asked:

SMTP server: mail.gov.in
Security type: SSL/TLS(Accept all Certificates)
Port: 465 (may be displayed automatically)
Require sign-in: **Must be checked / selected**
Username: Your aij.gov.in email user ID
Password: Your aij.gov.in email password
Then, click **Next**.

- Select Account / Email fetching options etc. as per your requirement, then click **Next**.
- Enter your name and other details, then select **Done** to complete the setup, if asked for.

(Note: IMAP setup screens may vary depending on the make/model of the mobile/tablet. Similar steps with some variation in steps / screens would also work for Apple Iphones / I pads)
