This petition taken up today for hearing at request through e.mail/ e.petition and after hearing the arguments of Thiru.A.Somasundaram, Advocate for the petitioners and of Thiru.M. Tamil Chelvan, the Public Prosecutor for the state over conference call, this court passed the following

**Order**

1. Petition for extension of time for surrender and execute the bail bond.
2. Heard both sides.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners as per order in Crl.M.P.No.6163/2020 dated 4.1.2021 with direction to surrender before the concerned court within 15 days from the date of order. But, unfortunately due to covid-19 curfew and pongal holidays, the petitioners are not able to produce the sureties as ordered by this court, in the meantime the time granted by this court was expired, hence requested further time to execute the bail bond. The learned Public Prosecutor has no serious objection.
4. The petitioners were granted anticipatory bail as per order in Crl.M.P.No. 6163/2020 dated 4.1.2021 directing the petitioners to surrender and produce sureties before the concerned court within 15 days from the date of

order failing which the bail stands cancelled. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the reasons assigned by the petitioners and in the interest of justice, this petition is allowed and as last chance, time is extended for **two weeks** from the date of passing this order to surrender and execute the bail bond and other conditions remain as such, further extension will not be entertained.
