Saturdays falling on 15<sup>th</sup> January, 19<sup>th</sup> February, 19<sup>th</sup> March, 16<sup>th</sup> April, 21<sup>st</sup> May, 18<sup>th</sup> June, 16<sup>th</sup> July, 20<sup>th</sup> August, 17<sup>th</sup> September, 15<sup>th</sup> October, 19<sup>th</sup> November, 17<sup>th</sup> December will be closed Saturdays of Subordinate Court.
3. \* Summer Vacation of Subordinate Court shall be from 16<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 to 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 and Winter Vacation from 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022.
4. Subordinate Courts will not observe the holidays declared or changed suddenly by the State Government/Competent Authority without approval of High Court.
5. The District Judge of the concerned district shall declare three Local holidays declared by the Collector/Commissioner of the concerned District or Tehsil without approval of the High Court under intimation to this Registry.
6. The holidays in respect of Id-ul-Fitar, Id-ul-Zuha, Moharrum and Id-milad un-Nabi are subject to change depending upon the visibility of moon.
