This case was registered by the respondent police against the  
Petitioner/Accused U/s.379 IPC

The Petitioner/Accused is arrested and sent to Judicial Custody on  
16.07.2020. The Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that Petitioner/Accused is  
innocent and he is no way connected with the allegation that has been level as  
against him in the present case. The police and Learned App raised that the  
Petitioner/Accused committed the offence and the investigation is still pending.

Heard both sides, Records Perused. Upon considering the fact of the case,  
Judicial custody for the past 14 days for the alleged offence U/s.379 IPC.,  
Whether the accused has committed the offence or not can be looked in the trial.  
The Presumption of innocence is in favor of the petitioner/ Accused till the  
accusation is to be proved.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and period of judicial  
custody and also in the interest of justice in my considered view of opinions is that  
the accused can be released on bail by imposing suitable condition for their  
presence. I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail on the following  
conditions.

1. The Accused is directed to execute own bond for sum of Rs.10,000/- to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent, Sub Jail, Usilampatti.
2. The Accused shall surrender before this court and execute bond along with two sureties for Rs.10,000/- each to the satisfaction of this within a period of 15 days after the withdrawal of Lockdown.
