Note I : Executive Holidays on account of Netaji's Birthday (January 23rd) and Christmas Day (December 25th) fall on Fourth Saturdays respectively and Independence Day (August 15th) falls on Sunday.

Note II : Public Holidays on account of Doljatra (28th March) and Rabindranath Tagore's Birthday (9th May) fall on Sundays.

Note III : In accordance with the Full Court Resolution dated 6.8.1992 second and fourth Saturdays of the respective Calendar month have been declared as Court Holidays.

Note IV : Holiday on account of Muslim Festivals viz. Id-Ui-Fitre and Id-Uz-Zoha (Bakrid) will be declared later on, depending on visibility of the moon.

Note V : In accordance with the Full Court resolution dated 01.12.2015 in the event the High Court declares an unscheduled Holiday, The Hon'ble The Chief Justice may exercise discretion to declare any "Non-working Day" as "Working Day" upon 07 (seven) days' notice, on consultation with Bar.
