

HOW TO INSTALL Microsoft Teams IN UBUNTU LAPTOP 16.04 / 14.04


1. Laptop's should be connected with internet
2. Right Click on the Desktop----- Open in Terminal

Then Run the following commands in Your Laptop (by typing in the terminal mode)

- I) `sudo apt update`
- II) `sudo apt install snapd`
- III) `sudo snap install teams-for-linux`

You'll need to enter in your system password , and then press enter, but the terminal will do all of the work for you. You'll see the progress bar, and once the installer is finished , you can see head to your list of applications , and search for Teams in the list, or launch it.

It is important to note , however , that for security reasons, you will need to manually enable support for the camera (front camera) before fully enjoying Teams on Ubuntu.
